

TUVISA awards GMV the project “Installation of closed-circuit surveillance cameras and a passenger information system”

Madrid, 24 January 2007.- The passenger-transport company Transporte Urbano de Vitoria S.A.(TUVISA) has awarded GMV the project for the “Installation of closed-circuit surveillance cameras and a passenger information system for eight night-service buses”. GMV is a technological business group offering products, services and solutions in a wide range of sectors: aeronautics, banking and finances, space, defense, healthcare, security, transport, telecommunications, information technologies for the government and large corporations.

With this project TUVISA meets its objective of increasing security on the night-service buses, avoiding incidents as far as possible and recording any that do happen on surveillance cameras.

This system, to be fitted on the buses in the coming weeks, consists of two surveillance cameras per bus. One of them will record images of any events that might occur in the driver’s area while the other will record everything that happens in the passenger area. As well as recording images the system will also record ambiental sound. The system is activated by the driver pushing an emergency button to start the recordings.

Both the images and the sound are recorded on a pen drive that can then be inserted in the image-analyzing computer. These images and sounds can also be downloaded by a WiFi network in the company’s bus depots.

The system also includes a passenger information system that will provide passengers with useful information from monitors fitted inside the bus.
